The Delaware County Board of Supervisors and ex-officio Board of Canvassers, for Delaware County, Iowa, met to certify the votes cast in this county at the **Lake Delhi Combined Recreational Facility and Water Quality District Trustee Election** held on the 21st day of July, 2020, as shown by the tally list returned from the election precinct, with all members present. Also present was County Auditor Carla K. Becker. Chairperson Jeff Madlom called the meeting to order at 2:00 p.m. Results of the canvass were as follows:

For the Office of Lake Delhi Combined Recreational Facility and Water Quality District Trustee there were 75 total votes cast of which Dennis J. Jasper received 23 votes, Steve Leonard received 14 votes, Dan Staebell received 21 votes, Rich Hughes received 4 votes and Bill Holsher received 1 vote. There were 0 over votes and 12 under votes.

Dennis J. Jasper, Steve Leonard and Dan Staebell were declared elected for a term of three (3) years.
